Starting in 2017, our shared enthusiasm for supply chain innovations propelled us to build The New York Supply Chain Meetup into the largest and fastest growing grassroots driven supply chain meetup in the world, within the first year.

Our success in New York led to the formation of The Worldwide Supply Chain Federation, a collaborative network of grassroots-driven supply chain communities that cooperate and partner with one another to galvanize supply chain innovators around the world.

Our collaboration with one another began with multiple conversations about what an early-stage venture fund that focuses exclusively on technology and innovation in global supply chain networks might accomplish given the opportunities that will arise as the world confronts climate change.

We have teamed up to build such a fund because we believe that the refashioning of manmade supply chains is the biggest opportunity of our lifetime. *Yoin us.*
